Suspension units in Hall 5

Ceiling suspension units are only available on request in Hall 5 over the full ceiling area.

The **maximum height** of the attachment points is **8.5 m** and these are provided by our (local) service provider Real Audio GmbH. **Maximum loads** of **10 kN** per point may be applied. Almost all suspension points are generated by individual rigging work.

To check whether we can provide the planned suspension points, we require a technical drawing from you with the following details:

1. Sketch with dimensions including the positions of the required suspension points.
All the details for the required suspension points
2. Clear alignment of your stand on the sketch (compass direction, neighbouring stand, etc.)
3. What type of suspension point is required?
250 kg chain hoist / 500 kg chain hoist / 130 kg wire cable holder
4. Suspended loads per point
5. Load diagram for total, single and distributed load
6. Required transfer height of the suspension points
7. Should the flying traverse and lighting system also be provided by our local supplier?

Exhibitors' own materials such as light systems or exhibits will be installed in compliance with current, accepted rules of engineering and the relevant regulations such as DIN, VDE und accident prevention regulations (in particular BGV C1).

Please note that a structural certificate is required for complex ceiling constructions suspended from the hall ceiling. After checking that it is reasonable, our rigging service provider reserves the right to have a structural engineer check and approve the loads and the ceiling construction if no structural calculation is provided. This check is not free and will be invoiced to the exhibitor. The prompt completion of the installation work by us can only be guaranteed if your purchase order is received by order deadline at the latest. Purchase orders received after this time will attract additional costs. These will be invoiced to the exhibitor.
